**Traveling West on I-290  
(Youngman Highway)**

**-Exit at Exit 1B (Delaware North)  
-Turn Right onto Delaware Ave**

**Traveling East on I-290  
(Youngman Highway)**

**-Exit at Exit 1 (Elmwood Ave)  
-Turn Left onto Knoche Rd  
and travel to its end  
-Turn left onto Delaware Ave.  
-Travel north under Youngman Overpass**

**-Turn Right at second street - Joseph Drive  
-Travel to end of Joseph Drive to O'Hara Road  
-Turn left and go 1 block to High School**
